The past.

We had the opportunity to purchase but did not have the money, an extensive effort to raise the funds, in the time allocated, \$570000 with only a few hundred in the bank seemed impossible.

We contacted every Bank, Credit Union, Motorcycle manufacturer, Accessory suppliers, government departments, Sporting Organisations, MA and MNSW, within our area all without any interest to help.

Club members were asked to take part in a scheme, where they could make donations or purchases advanced membership, on the understanding, if the Club failed to purchase the land their money would be returned. This raised the 10% deposit required by the NSW government.

Still a long way to go, after much discussion, the Campbelltown branch of Westpac agreed to loan the club \$300,000 holding the land as security, we were still \$200,000 short and time running out fast. A long time club member, mortgaged his house and loaned the required amount to the club, with less than two hours from deadline, our solicitor paid the government and the land was ours, or would be when we had clear our debts.
